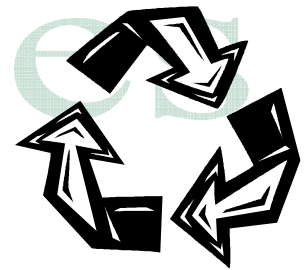


BGM Recycles

<i>Material</i>	<i>Items Accepted</i>	<i>Preparation Needed</i>	<i>Not Recyclable</i>	<i>Other Special Items</i>
<u>Glass</u>	Clear, green, and brown bottles and jars.	Discard caps, lids, and ring but labels can be left on.	No fluorescent bulbs, light bulbs, white glass, plate glass, ceramics, crystal, cups or dishes.	Yard waste Leaves, grass clippings, wood ash, sawdust and garden waste. Use approved bags and tags.
<u>Plastic</u>	Numbers 1 and 2	Rinse out and remove caps and rings.	No oil, antifreeze or pesticide containers. No film, plastic grocery bags, bread sacks, etc.	
<u>Paper</u>	Office paper; Computer paper; Newspapers and glossy inserts; Magazines; Catalogs; Phone books.	Keep paper clean and dry. Place in brown paper or plastic shopping bags.	No food wrappings or wax or plastic coated paper products.	
<u>Cardboard</u>	Corrugated and non-corrugated. Includes cereal-type boxes and egg cartons.	Flatten and remove any foreign inserts.	Contact your hauler with questions.	
<u>Metal</u>	Food and drink cans, tin and aluminum foil.	Rinse and remove labels.	No aerosol or paint cans, chrome-plated or galvanized metals.
