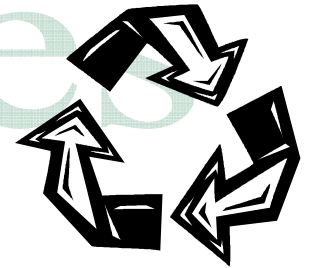


Pella Recycles

<i>Material</i>	<i>Items Accepted</i>	<i>Preparation Needed</i>	<i>Not Recyclable</i>	<i>Other Special Items</i>
<u>Glass</u>	Clear or brown bottles and jars.	Rinse. Discard caps, lids, and ring but labels can be left on.	No windows, ceramics, dishes, light bulbs, mirrors, pottery, or drinking glasses.	Yard Waste Pick up on Wednesdays. Must use special yard waste bags.
<u>Plastic</u>	Rigid containers with numbers 1, 2, and 3.	Rinse out and remove caps, lids, and rings. Labels can be left on containers.	No numbers 4 - 7 and no pesticide or antifreeze containers. No Styrofoam, bags, toys, or Tupperware type containers.	
<u>Paper</u>	White and colored office paper, newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs, books, junk mail, and phone books.	Please separate and bundle paper items.	No waxed paper.	
<u>Cardboard</u>	Corrugated and non-corrugated. Includes cereal-type boxes and other packaging.	Flatten and remove any foreign inserts.	Milk cartons, cereal boxes, and other non-corrugated items.	
<u>Metal</u>	Food and drink cans, aluminum pie pans, foil.	Rinse and remove labels. Crushed preferred	No paint or aerosol cans, metal pots and pans, kitchen appliances, furniture, or aluminum siding.
