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UNCOVERED AND UNSECURED LOADS POLICY

The South Central Iowa Solid Waste Agency believes all loads of waste and/or recyclables being delivered to the Landfill should be **completely covered and /or secured** in such a way to prevent littering on the roadways. Loads of material delivered to the Landfill must be fully covered and the cover secured to prevent littering from the point of origin to the designated unloading point.

Tarps that are shredded or no longer able to adequately cover loads will be considered non-compliant. Tarps that are tied so loosely as to allow materials to fall or blow out will be considered non-compliant.

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Note that this requirement also applies to recyclables materials such as newspapers, plastics, and so forth.

Exceptions: If not mixed with other types of waste or recyclables, appliances, scrap metal and tires do not need to be tarped. However, they must be secured in such a way that they will not fall or blow out of the delivery vehicle.

For private individuals: Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in a \$10 (ten dollar) surcharge being assessed.

For commercial haulers: Failure to comply with this requirement shall result in a \$100 (one hundred dollar) surcharge being assessed.

Use of Surcharge: The Agency will retain the surcharge to assist in anti-litter education campaigns and to help pay for the collection of litter and clean-up of illegal dump sites.
