

Show us your favorite way to Reduce, Reuse, Recycle! Do you recycle at home? Or maybe you re-use glass jars as storage...or you might take re-useable bags to the grocery store. Draw a picture in the box above - use your artistic skills to make it colorful with markers, crayons, or colored pencils. Keep your picture within the frame and in a vertical position.

Re-duce, Re-use, Recycle...

We all know the 3 R's but sometimes we forget that easy things like reducing, re-using, and recycling really can make a difference!

Even if you know the 3R's you may not recognize the waste hierarchy pyramid, a picture that shows us the most effective methods for reducing our waste. Notice that the 3R's are represented at the very top of the pyramid: prevention and minimization are forms of "Reduce" followed by "Reuse" and "Recycling" as the most preferred ways to manage your waste. Energy recovery and disposal are considered to be the least desirable or "last options" for getting rid of something.

The next time you throw something away stop and think: is there is a way to Reduce, Re-use or Recycle? Maybe you can reuse it - or recycle the item this time but find re-usable alternatives for next time. As we all try to reduce the amount of waste we landfill it's good to remember that the 3R's are still a great way make a positive environmental impact.
