- Aerosol Cleaners, Paints
- Ammonia-Based Cleaners
- Antifreeze
- Batteries
- Fertilizers & Weed Killer
- Fluorescent and LED Light Bulbs
- Gasoline, Kerosene
- Oil, Lead-Based Paint
- Stains, Varnishes
- Metal Polishes, Rust Removers
- Thermometers & Thermostats (Mercury)
- Pesticides
- Petroleum Adhesives
- Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters
- Sharps or Needles (must be contained)
  - Use detergent bottles or sharp containers (not milk jugs or pop bottles). Lids must be taped.

### *what's not accepted?*

- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Business Waste
- Electronics
- Explosives
- Fire Extinguishers
- Latex Paint
- Medications
- Propane tanks, cylinders
- Radioactive materials

If you miss this event, you can also take your items to the Metro Northwest Transfer Station in Grimes the second Saturday of each month, March – November, 8 AM - Noon.
